During English sessions, we will explore persuasive writing, letters and a range of fiction work based on our guided reading books for the half term.

Maths sessions will focus upon place value and the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

In Science, we will study living things and their habitats. This will include the classification of plants and animals, reproduction and life cycles.
