



Topic: Where in the World? UK and Non-EU Countries

Welcome back everyone! We all hope you had a wonderful summer break and are now raring to go for the new school year. We are looking forward to an exciting year ahead where we get to work with some new and familiar faces in our classes this year and we are sure everyone will enjoy seeing each other once again.

Our topic in KS1 for this half term is "Where in the world?". This is a geography inspired topic which gives us an opportunity to explore the different countries that make up the UK as well as the capital cities. We will also be looking at other non-European countries and comparing them as part of our learning. In maths and English, the Year 1 and 2 children will access a range of age appropriate learning. Year 1 will begin by consolidating counting and basic maths skills whereas Year 2 children will be exploring numbers 10-100 and exploring some calculations within 20. In English, the children will be looking at narrative writing, descriptions and letter writing, all linked to some of our class texts. Our science topic for this half term is 'Animals including Humans' and in RE, we will be looking at 'Creation'.

We are excited to be accessing areas of the curriculum with our home groups this year. In PE, we will begin looking at a range of games where we can attack, defend and shoot. In music, the children will be investigating what we can discuss when listening to music and in PSHE, the children will be looking at physical health and wellbeing.

All of the staff in the Key Stage One team are excited to begin our journey through Key Stage One this year and we are always here to help or answer any questions you may have. Please don't hesitate to ask any of the team.
