



Topic: Where in the World?
Frozen Kingdom

Welcome back everyone! We hope you have had a wonderful summer and are ready for the new school year. This year, the Year 5/6 team will be supported by Mrs Pepper, Mrs Taylor, Miss Garthwaite and Mrs Strachan. We've already made an amazing start to the new term - the children are already making us proud and being super role models to the rest of the school.

Our topic for this half term is "Where in the world? Frozen Kingdom". This is a geography-based topic which gives us an opportunity to explore the Arctic and Antarctica, mapping the polar regions and learning more about their human and physical features. In Art we will be creating prints and for DT we will design and make structures. In Science, we will be learning about Forces, finding out more about gravity, air and water resistance and friction, and exploring mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears. In RE, we will be exploring Christian beliefs about creation and how humans are responsible for looking after the planet. We will be looking at E-Safety in our computing sessions. In PE, we will be developing attacking, defending and shooting skills for invasion games and we will be looking at Physical Health and Mental Wellbeing in PSHE.

In Maths, we will be consolidating our knowledge of number and place value with larger numbers before moving onto calculation skills. Alongside this, we will be practising basic skills including addition facts and times tables to make sure our recall of number facts and mental calculation skills support our learning; practising these at home and regularly using TTRockstars would be really helpful. In English, we will be developing our sentence level skills and writing a range of texts inspired by our topic work as well as our reading texts. We will also be celebrating National Poetry Day in October by reading, performing and writing poetry.
