Topic: Ancient Egypt

Welcome back to school everyone. I hope you all had a very restful break and are looking forward to another half-term of exciting activities.

I am very excited to inform you that this half-term our topic will be "Ancient Egypt". As a great interest of my own, I am looking forward to travelling back in time with you all to learn about what life was like for the Ancient Egyptians and looking at their construction of tombs. Alongside this, I am hoping that we will be able to undertake our school trip to the Hands of History museum to further enrich our topic and learn more about this fascinating part of history. As well as our history topic, we will be constructing with modroc in Art linked to Ancient Egypt, whilst we continue to look at relationships and keeping ourselves safe on and offline in PSHE and ICT. In RE, we will be building on our prior learning of incarnation and looking at the importance of the birth of Jesus in the bible. In Science, we will be looking at forces and magnets and how friction impacts the movement of objects.

In Maths, we will be consolidating our knowledge of multiplication and division to further support our learning of written mathematics and aid in our development of the times tables. We will also continue our focus on times-tables and learning new facts of 4x and 8x. It would massively benefit your progress if this could also be a focus at home, as well as using TTRockstars as often as possible. In English, we will continue embedding grammar and spelling rules, building on our correct letter formation and handwriting style, as well as focussing on text types, such as diary entries and writing non-chronological reports based on our Ancient Egypt topic.
