



Topic: World War Two

We hope you had a lovely break and are ready for another busy half term in Year 5/6. As you will know, this year we are moving our Key Stage 2 play to the summer term to allow us to maximise learning time in the autumn term and allow us to really celebrate our Year 6s in the summer term once their SATs are completed. This term we will be holding a music and carols evening as an alternative where our school musicians will have the opportunity to share festive pieces with us and we can enjoy carol singing and mince pies - please join us on Tuesday 12th December at 6pm!

Our topic for this half term is "World War Two". This is a history-based topic where we will be learning about the start of World War Two and how Britain stood firm including learning about evacuation. In DT we will design and make structures and in Art we will study the work of Henry Moore including charcoal sketches from WW2 and sculpture. In Science, we will be learning more about Forces focusing on air and water resistance, and mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears, then moving on to start a new topic on materials and their properties. In RE, we will be exploring Christian beliefs about Christmas and how Christians believe Jesus is the Messiah and how they follow Jesus. We will be looking at E-Safety in our computing sessions. In PE, we will be working on orienteering outdoors this half term and we will be looking at Physical Health and Mental Wellbeing in PSHE.

In Maths, we will be consolidating our calculation skills using all four operations. Alongside this, we will be practising basic skills including addition facts and times tables to make sure our recall of number facts and mental calculation skills support our learning; practising these at home and regularly using TTRockstars would be really helpful. In English, we will be developing our sentence level skills and writing a range of texts inspired by our topic work as well as our reading texts.
