

We hope you have a had a lovely half term break! Year 6 will be preparing for the KS2 SATs next term w/c Monday 13th May. Join us next Monday for more information on how to best support your child in the run-up to SATs and help them be secondary-school ready, as well as information on our upcoming Year 5/6 residential next term. This half term, our topic is Earth and Space; in Science we will be learning about the movement of the Earth and moon and explaining why we have day and night. We will learn about the history of space exploration and learning about time zones around the world in Geography. In Art, we will be exploring art by Peter Thorpe and investigating colour and line drawing. In RE, we will be learning about Salvation, focusing on what Christians believe about Jesus' resurrection, how these beliefs are shown through worship on Good Friday and Easter Sunday and the impact of these beliefs for Christians. We will be improving our chromebook skills and learning programming skills in our computing sessions. In PE, we will be working on tennis skills this half term and we will be looking at respecting ourselves and others and relationships in PSHE.

In Maths, we will continue improving the accuracy of our calculation skills using all four operations, calculating using fractions, mixed numbers and percentages. Alongside this, we will be practising basic skills including addition facts and times tables; practising these at home and regularly using TTRockstars would be really helpful. In English, we will be developing our sentence level skills and writing a range of texts inspired by our topic work as well as our reading texts. You can support at home by encouraging your child to use Lexia for reading and Spelling Shed to practise spelling rules. We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 7th March - children are invited to come dressed as their favourite book character. We will be promoting reading for pleasure by sharing books we love and enjoying short stories.
