## Year 3/4

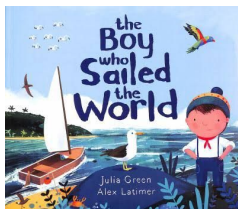
**\*Forest schools kits are still needed for the afternoon\***
