



Topic: Our Planet Brilliant Biomes

We hope you've had a wonderful Easter break; welcome back to a busy summer term, including **Key Stage 2 SATs Week Monday 13th - Thursday 16th May** when Year 6 will be able to show off their super skills and learning from across KS2 in their SATs tests - we are so proud of them already! We are also looking forward to our **Year 5/6 residential to Peat Rigg Wednesday 24th - Friday 26th April**.

This half term our topic is Our Planet: Brilliant Biomes where we will be learning about the location and features of Earth's different biomes and ecosystems and how these can be protected. In Science, we will be learning about materials and their properties with a focus on reversible and irreversible changes to materials. In RE, we will be learning about how different faiths value forgiveness. We will be improving our chromebook skills and learning how to create media. In PE, we will be working on hitting and catching skills this half term and we will be looking at respecting ourselves and others and relationships in PSHE.

In maths, we will continue securing our written calculation methods - quick recall of times tables and division facts are essential so practising these regularly at home will support your child's learning in Maths. Year 5 will be focusing on factors and multiples, then understanding fractions and calculating using fractions and Year 6 will be consolidating understanding in preparation for Year 6 SATs and revisiting any areas of the curriculum as needed. In English, we will be developing our sentence level skills and writing a range of texts inspired by our topic work and our reading texts. You can support at home by encouraging your child to use Lexia for reading and Spelling Shed to practise spelling rules.
